E-Safety—Please read the following advice /recommendation from a arent

'Kids Place' is available free from the Google App Store or Amazon App Store. It allows you to define what apps your children can use and also allows you to lock down the internet. 'Kids Place Screen Time' is an add-on app also free from the Google App Store or Amazon App Store, which allows you to define when your child(ren) can use the device and also for how long each day. I've found this invaluable for limiting screen time.

Clothing- It's getting colder! Please ensure your child has a coat and appropriate outdoor clothing (labelled with their name) for cold and wet weather. We will try to get the children outside at breaks and lunch whenever possible.
