




Peek at the Week

Friday 20th January

We have had a very enjoyable week in Waveney class. This week's learning has been based on *Roaring Rockets* by Tony Mitton and Ant Parker. We have been talking about the difference between fiction and non-fiction books. We have done some work on rhyming words. We have been recapping on 2D shape names by making rockets, lunar landers and moon buggies from 2D shapes and then we wrote a list of the shapes we used. We have been writing characters' thoughts and feelings and made a list of what we would need to do to get ready to go to the moon. We had great fun playing with moon sand too! Lots of us have found out really interesting facts about the moon and planets and some of us tried to walk in gravity boots - it was hard work!
