




Peek at the Week

Friday 31st March



We have had a busy term in Waveney Class. The children have really enjoyed learning about hot and cold places. This week our focus book was *Handa's Hen*. We listened to the story and watched an animation of it. Some children counted the creatures in the story and some children counted objects in 2s. We wrote our own versions of the story changing elements such as the characters and described the creatures using adjectives related to size, shape, pattern and colour. We have learnt about the life cycle of a hen and talked about other animals that come out of eggs. We also looked at the butterflies in the story and made symmetrical butterflies by painting one half and folding them. We have made giant birds' nests outside and role played at being birds. We have changed the outdoor hut into an airport and have enjoyed going on holidays to hot places. We have also been busy making Easter cards.

REMINDER Read lots in the holidays. The local libraries have lots of lovely picture books and you can borrow around twenty at a time. They also have other holiday activities, including crafts and construction sessions - check out what's going on at your nearest one.
