




# Peek at the Week

We have had an enjoyable week in Waveney Class. We have moved from learning about cold places to hot places, so this week we have our focus book has been *Handa's Surprise* by Eileen Browne, which is set in Africa. We have written about what we would take to a friend if we were going to visit them. We sequenced pictures and events from the story. We

also wrote in speech bubbles. We have compared the weights of different fruits and have weighed them using cubes. The nursery children have counted fruits and the Reception children used fruit to write addition sentences. The children have enjoyed retelling the story by acting it out or using Small World play sets. We tasted and printed with fruits and made African necklaces. We have also made observational still life drawings of a basket of fruit and simple batik effect pictures.
