




# Peek at the Week

Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June

We have had a busy week in Waveney class. We have become pirates and have done lots of pirate themed activities because our book of the week has been Mungo and the Pirates by Timothy Knapman. We have learnt some pirate words and made up names for pirates. We talked about what jobs pirates need to do on a ship and made a list. In Maths Reception have been adding the values of coins together and have continued to work on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. The Nursery children looked at two and three colour patterns and used what they have learnt to create stripy handprint sails for pirate ships. We made super paper plate pirates and used feathers to create brightly coloured parrots. We also made pirate ships and pirates using handprints.
