




Peek at the Week

Friday 20th October

We have come to the end of our first half term in Early Years. I think you'll agree it has been a very busy one. This week our focus story has been *The Frog Prince*.

We have learnt about the life cycle of a frog and practised ball skills in PE, pretending to play with golden balls. The children that know their letter sounds have used them to make cvc words to go with pictures of objects. We have listened to rhyming stories and made pairs of rhyming words. Some of us found words that rhymed with 'frog'. We have looked at pictures of frogs and written captions to go with them. We have thrown frog beanbags on to 2D shapes and have worked on subtraction by singing *Five Little Speckled Frogs*. We made frogs from cardboard tubes and decorated them to look like a specific type of frog by looking carefully at pictures. We also made handprint frogs on logs.



In phonics we have learnt *h b fl*. If your child has a sound mat in their book bag, encourage them to say the sound and write the letter. The Reception children have also been learning the first high frequency words *I no go to the into*.

★ Well done to those children who are coming into school and sorting out their things independently. All the Reception children should be able to do this independently after the holiday. ★
