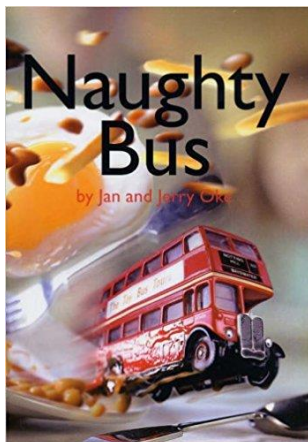




Peek at the Week

We have had a very busy week in Waveney Class. This week's theme book has been *Naughty Bus* by Jan and Jerry Oke.

We have made our own versions of the story into books in small groups and wrote one or two sentences about what it did the next day. We made a collage of a London bus and counted out people into the bus. We made BeeBots into buses and programmed them to go forwards and backwards to reach a specific destination. We have been using positional language (*in, on, under, over, through and above*), placing vehicles in a particular place and saying a complete sentence. We added together the number of wheels on two vehicles and were introduced to the add and equals signs. In the story the naughty bus goes through a breakfast, and the Nursery children have had great fun making tracks with buses through baked beans, jelly and silly soap. We also talked about what we have for breakfast.

*** Well done to those children who have been reading at home. It is really important that this is done at home every day, as well as learning numbers and letter sounds. ***
