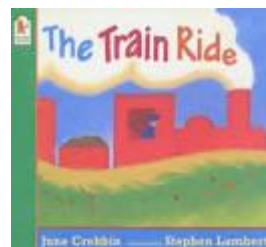




# Peek at the Week

What a busy week we have had in Waveney Class. Our theme book this week has been *The Train Ride* by June Crebbin and Stephen Lambert. We have made story maps to retell the book and some of us made up our own fantastic stories. We have put numbered carriages in order, not necessarily beginning at 1. We used Numicon apparatus to add numbers by counting on. We made shape trains and named the shapes that we used. We painted trains and used 3D shaped blocks to print trains on a track. We made a big train using the wooden blocks outside and pretended to go on journeys.
