




Peek at the Week

Friday 23rd March



This week in Waveney class the children have joined in with lots of monster activities as our theme book has been *Don't Call Me Sweet* by Smriti Prasadam-Halls. The children drew a picture from the story and wrote about their favourite part and what they like about the little monster. We made monsters using different shapes and used phonic flips to make up names for them. We have written recipes for food for a monster's party, with ingredients like spiders, eyeballs, toe nails and bones and we wrote instructions about how to be a scary monster. We painted stones to create stone monsters and used them for weighing and we have done lots of activities related to counting, number bonds and subtraction. We used a computer program to create monsters, using the mouse to operate the program, which was good practice of mouse skills. We painted monster pictures and blew paint through a giant straw to make strange monsters and we explored a sensory tray of jelly, stones, peas, marbles and bugs, pretending to make monster food.

On Wednesday we went on a nature walk to look for signs of spring. We saw daffodils and crocuses and we heard birds singing in the trees. We even saw a bumble bee buzzing around the flowers.
