




# Peek at the Week

What a lovely week we have had in Waveney class. Our bird activities have been based on the book *Wings!* by Paul Stewart and Jane Porter. At the beginning of the week we experimented with finding a way to make a toy penguin fly and wrote some instructions. We have learnt to recognise lots of garden birds and some of us wrote descriptions and facts about them. In maths the Reception children put the house point tokens into groups of tens to count them and they investigated the values of Cuisenaire rods. The nursery children used 2D shapes to make animals and talked about the features of model animals. The children were very keen to turn the role play area into a zoo, so we have been busy painting animals, making signs, writing facts and making tickets.
