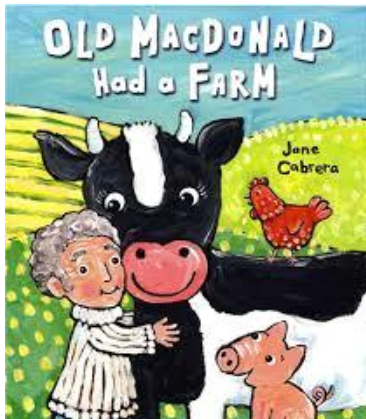




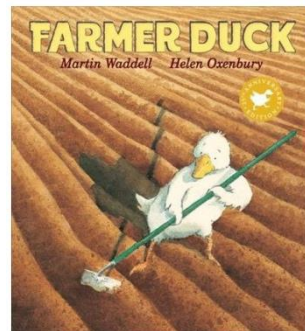
Peek at the Week
