




Peek at the Week

Friday 5th October

We have had a lovely week in Waveney Class. Our theme this week has been 12345 Once I Caught a Fish Alive. The children have been doing lots of counting and ordering numbers to ten and number recognition. They fished for numbered fish and put them in sequence. Some of the children added two groups together and found the total. We looked at photographs of fish and learnt the names of some of them and we worked in groups to write a caption to go with a picture of



something on the end of a fishing rod. We listened to the story *Rainbow Fish* by Marcus Pfister and created our own fish using handprints, embellishing them with sequins. Our role play area is now a fish and chip shop and the children have been writing menus and orders. We made a fishing boat outside and did lots of fishing. We have also talked about left and right. We have started working on Phase 2 phonics, this week focussing on the initial letter sounds *s a t p* and on listening to 'robot talk' words, blending sounds together to identify CVC words (e.g. bus, zip, mug, cup etc).



Well done to **Reuben Rankin** who is Waveney Class's Star of the Week. You did some fantastic adding to 20, completed a really tricky jigsaw puzzle and have had lots of fantastic ideas when playing. We hope you have fun with *Star the Pony!*
