




Peek at the Week

We have come to the end of our first half term in Early Years. I think you'll agree it has been a very busy one. This week, we have been focussing on Incy Wincy Spider. We have learnt about spiders and have written fact sheets. We went outside and looked for webs - there were hundreds! We have been writing for lots of purposes - notes, messages and lists. We are still focussing on correct pencil grip, writing names and forming letters correctly. In maths we have been counting spiders' legs, and finding different ways of making 8.

On Friday we celebrated Black History Month by looking at *So Amazing* by the artist Sonia Boyce and creating our own.



We made spiders and webs using a wide range of materials and techniques and creating little dens for spiders. We have been using black sparkly play dough to create spiders.
