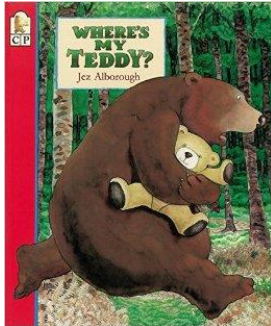




Peek at the Week

Friday 2nd November



It is lovely to have the children back after the holiday. We hope you all had a good half term break. This half term we are focussing on Woodlands and Bears as our topics. Our theme book this week has been Where's My Teddy? By Jez Alborough. We have enjoyed the story and participating in lots of activities related to it.

*We have talked about adjectives to describe bears and some of us have written sentences about bears. We talked about feeling lost and what we would do if we were lost. In maths we measured teddy bears using objects and some of us even used rulers. We also compared the weights of two bears using the language **heavy** and **light**. We also made shape bears using 2D shapes and shape cutters.*

We made teddy bear faces using paint with forks to make them fluffy and using bread, chocolate spread and fruit. Some of the children built a bonfire and pretended to make hot chocolate in the mud kitchen. Others used musical instruments to make their own music.

Reminder - Some children haven't been bringing fruit for afternoon snack. This can either be a piece of fruit or chopped fruit in a named container.
