




Peek at the Week

Friday 16th November



We have had a busy time in Waveney class this week. Our learning has been based on *The Gruffalo* by Julia Donaldson. We have talked about pictures from the story and written captions to go with them. We used masks to retell the story. We have talked about our favourite characters and made a bar graph to show our favourites and made pictograms of our favourite ice-creams - can you guess how many children said they would like to try owl ice cream? In maths we have continued to work hard with our counting, number recognition and writing numbers. We have also continued to work on adding two and three groups of objects together. We have made pictures of the animals from the story using shapes. We had fun weaving wool around snakes and painting Gruffalos focussing on the features. We have been revising shape names and repeating patterns.

We have started to learn the songs for our Nativity play. If your child has lines, please help them to learn them (they will be sent out next Monday).

Every child now has high frequency words on a string to learn. Can you practise them every day and make sure they stay in the book bags. Thank you.
