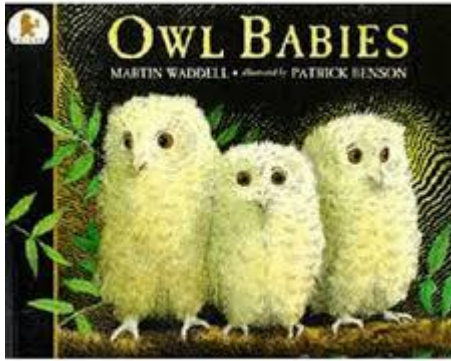




Peek at the Week
