We have had a lovely week in Waveney Class. Our theme book has been *The Way Back Home* by Oliver Jeffers. We watched a film of the story and wrote about it, then read the book and compared the two versions.

We took part in a problem-solving activity working in pairs to make something to help the alien get down from space (e.g. ladders, chutes). The children worked well together sharing their ideas. We also made aliens in flying saucers and recreated the front cover of the book using a variety of media.

It was very exciting on Friday morning when the big crane came - we watched it unload wood piles for the new garden. As well as our theme activities, we celebrated Chinese New Year, which was on Tuesday. We listened to the story and ordered the animals according to where they finished in the race. We watched a film about a family's celebrations, we measured dragons, made dragon masks and had a go at using chopsticks with pretend noodles. Some of us did some Chinese writing too.
