




# Peek at the Week

Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April



We have had a busy term in Waveney Class. The children have really enjoyed learning about hot and cold places. This week our focus book was *Handa's Hen*. We listened to the story and watched an animation of it. Some children counted the creatures in the story and some children found different ways of making 6 in an egg box. We have learnt about the life cycle of a hen and talked about

other animals that come out of eggs. We also looked at the butterflies in the story and made symmetrical butterflies by painting one half and folding them. We wrote letters to the Easter Bunny related to the story of Saving Easter and we have also been busy making Easter cards to our own designs. As it's the end of the term, we have been finding out what the children have learnt in Phonics and Maths in preparation for next term.

Read lots in the holidays. The local libraries have lots of lovely picture books and you can borrow around twenty at a time. They also have other holiday activities, including crafts and construction sessions - check out what's going on at your nearest one.
