




Peek at the Week

What a busy week we have had in Waveney Class. We have carried on our theme of vegetables and our theme books have been the Supertato stories by Sue Hendra. We have written character profiles for Supertato and an evil pea. We made superheroes out of potatoes and enjoyed playing with them. We talked about things that you can make from potatoes, such as mash and chips. In maths, Reception have been printing potatoes counting in ones or twos up to 20, or beyond. We have been exploring heavy and light using balancing scales. We designed our own superheroes and gave them super powers. The Reception children also used phonics to create superhero sound pictures like POW and KERPOW! The children updated their bean diaries and planted their beanstalks into pots of soil.
