We looked for holey leaves that caterpillars had been nibbling and looked for other insects as we walked. Some of us saw slugs, woodlice, spiders and snails. We entered a very well equipped mud kitchen where we made lots more food for the caterpillar. We even saw a tiny green caterpillar hanging from a leaf where we made flower pictures on the ground with leaves, petals, stones and twigs. After lunch we had a play then we made creatures using a ball of clay and some natural objects. The children were very creative - there were owls, mice, snails, rabbits, snakes, and many other creatures.



At the end of the day we listened to a story about some woodland creatures that lived in a box. We had a fabulous time. Your children loved being outdoors in the woods - we hope you will follow up this interest by visiting woodlands, meadows and beaches to try out some of these activities.
