



Peek at the Week

Friday 1st November



Welcome back. We hope you had a good holiday. This week we have been learning about autumn and our theme book for the week has been Chicken Licken. We have looked at and described autumn leaves, talking about the colours, shapes and textures. We talked about the characters in



the story and what they said. Some of us wrote the words into speech bubbles. We also sequenced events in the story and some of us wrote captions. In maths we have been learning about 7 in a wide range of contexts - money, time, measurement. We looked at numbers 1 to 10 on tens grids and some of us wrote number sentences by adding two grids together. We investigated square-based pyramids and compared them with the other 3D shapes that we know. We did lots of weighing using autumn materials, such as conkers using the language **heavier lighter balance**. We have printed with leaves, made leaf pictures and used finger painting to create autumn trees. In Phonics, the Year 1 children are revising Phase 3 and Reception have started Phase 2. This week's sounds were **s a t p**. We have been learning to write the letters and read and write some CVC words. We have been busy in our outdoor shop and we are enjoying our new writing hut. We have also been practising riding the balance bikes, ready for our sponsored event next week (weather permitting). We hope you are collecting lots of sponsors as there are lots of things we would love to buy for the outdoor area.
