



# Peek at the Week

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November



We have been so busy in Waveney class this week. We have enjoyed learning about different reasons why we have fireworks. We listened to the story of Guy Fawkes and talked about firework safety, made firework pictures and wrote firework sounds.



We have also been talking about the celebration Diwali. We read a storybook called Diwali and we acted out the story of Rama and Sita. We made Rangoli patterns, Mehndi patterns and Diwa lamps.



In maths we investigated number eight in a range of contexts including money, capacity and measurement. We used money in our outdoor role play area and counted the coins. We have also explored symmetrical pictures and created our own ones using conkers, beads and wood slices. We have made eight in different ways using our fingers, Numicon and tens frame and counters. We talked about halving and cut shapes into halves.

In Phonics, this week's sounds were **i n m d**. We have been learning to write the letters and read and write some CVC words.
