




Peek at the Week

Friday 22nd November



This week we have been focussing our learning on our collection of old toys. Our theme story has been *Lost in the Toy Museum* by David Lucas. We have really enjoyed sewing our own toys or puppets.

In maths we have been halving items and amounts and we learnt about hemispheres. We have learnt about number 9 and explored it in a wider context including weight, measurement, capacity and time. We also counted pictures of toys and wrote the numbers.

In Phonics, this week's sounds were **ck e u r**. **ck** is the first digraph that we have learnt. We say it is **2 letters 1 sound** and is at the end of some words, like duck, pack, sock and in the middle of others, such as bucket, pocket ticket. Year 1 are continuing to focus on Phase 3 digraphs and are being encouraged to use them in their independent writing.

We have been busy learning the songs for the Nativity play. We have allocated parts and costumes. These children are snowflakes (Amy Isaac Emily B Ella Rory Martha) - they will need to bring a plain white t-shirt and white leggings or tights in a named carrier bag. Everyone else has a costume already.
