




Peek at the Week

Friday 7th February



This week we have been learning about weather associated with different seasons and our theme book was *One Winter's Day*. We talked about what happens in winter and investigated ice and measured temperatures using thermometers. We discovered that ice was 0. We made winter pictures using a variety of resources and used the cold tone palette for printing. We looked at a variety of clothing and talked about the properties of the materials. Then we sorted the clothes by which weather we would wear them in and wrote captions to go with pictures of characters in different types of weather.



In Maths we talked about number 15, place value (tens and units column). We made pizzas and talked about cutting them in halves and quarters. We looked at objects around the classroom and described them by the features of their shape

In Phonics one group has been learning **oo ar or ur** reading words and having a go at writing them. The other group has worked on Phase 4 blends. The intervention group has been revising recognising letter sounds and writing CVC words.

In PSHE we talked about responsibilities and what it means to be responsible, that 'helping hands' jobs are a responsibility.

The Nursery children have been clapping syllables of their names, counting backwards from 10 by taking 1 away and winter weather and clothing. They also made winter pictures and experimented with making colours.
