




# Peek at the Week

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February



Welcome back. We hope you all had a good holiday. We loved reading about the activities you did together at home. This week our learning has all been linked to pancakes!

We read Mr Wolf's Pancakes. We made pancakes and enjoyed eating them. We wrote lists of ingredients and sequenced how we made them.

In PSHE we talked about different ways we can keep healthy, such as exercising, eating a healthy diet and the importance of having a good night's sleep.

In phonics we learnt **air ure** and **er** and tricky words **my** and **her**. We have learnt all the Phase 3 sounds and tricky words so we will go on to revision of them, focussing on writing.

In Maths we explored number 17, counting forwards and backwards. We talked about place value (how many tens how many units and wrote it on the part part whole model. We also counted irregular arrangements of objects and identified 1 more and 1 less by adding and removing objects. We used our number knowledge to solve some number problems involving addition, subtraction and sharing. We also read The Doorbell Rang and shared out cookies between 2,3 and 4 children.

The Nursery children have been retelling their holiday news in the correct order, focussing on using past tenses of verbs. They have sorted collections by listening to the initial sounds and practised writing the letter sounds in sand. They made shape pictures using 2D shapes and attempted to name them. They acted out a pancake song based on taking away, drew a picture from the story and did some mark-making
