

Science Lesson 3 Monday 4th May:

In Science we would have been focusing on the topic 'animals including humans'. The third lesson is to understand what you need to survive (this also links to our history topic, explorers). You only need to choose option 1 or option 2, don't feel you need to do both.

Activity 1/ Introduction:

Discuss what it would be like if you were stranded on a desert island. Discuss what you would need to survive.

Option 1 (Maybe spend around 30minutes on the island):

Create a 'desert island' in a room (you could just use a blanket on the floor and say the child cannot leave the blanket— unless they need the toilet obviously). Give them an old plastic bottle/cup and scrap paper and a pencil. Ask your child to send you messages of the things they need to survive.

Afterwards, discuss which things they actually needed and which things they didn't. Decide on 5 things you would bring to a desert island and why.

Option 2:

Draw yourself on a desert island with 5 things that you would bring with you. Write a sentence for each item that you choose and explain why you would bring it.
