

Phonics Lesson (Year 1) Tuesday 16th June:

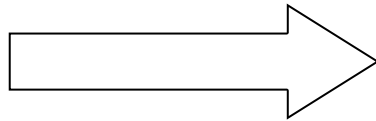
This lesson will make more sense if you go through the phonics PowerPoint first.

Rules to remember from the PowerPoint:

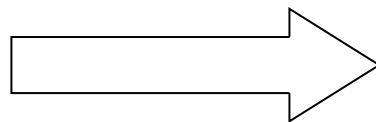
- If a noun (a person/place or thing) ends in s, z, sh, ch OR x you add es rather than just s when making it plural (when there's more than one thing).
- If a verb (an action word like run) ends in s, z, sh, ch OR x you add es rather than just s when it is in the present tense (if it is happening right now e.g. the dog runs for the ball)

Make these words plural:

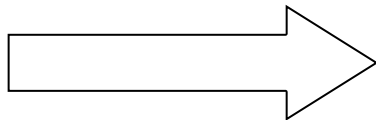

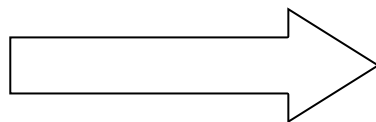
