

## Phonics Lesson Year 2 - 23.06.20 and 30.06.20

For phonics this week and next week I thought it would be really fun to create your own board game with all the phase 5 sounds. It's up to you what the rules are but here is an example of how you could make it. Have one of the sounds from below on most squares and when you land on them you have to think of a word that has that sound in, if you can't think of one you go back 3 spaces. However, I'm sure you all have more creative ideas of ways the board game could work. Below is a list of all the phase 5 sounds with examples of a word with that sound in:

- ay (play)
- ou (sound)
- ie (tie)
- ea (bead)
- oy (boy)
- ir (girl)
- ue (glue) *Makes the 'oo' sound rather than the 'you' sound*
- ue (statue) *Makes the 'you' sound rather than the 'oo' sound*
- aw (saw)
- wh (whistle)
- ph (dolphin)
- ew (screw) *Makes the 'oo' sound rather than the 'you' sound*
- ew (stew) *Makes the 'you' sound rather than the 'oo' sound*
- oe (toe)
- au (haunted)
- ey (monkey)
- a-e (snake)
- e-e (eve)
- i-e (slide)
- o-e (bone)
- u-e (flute) *Makes the 'oo' sound rather than the 'you' sound*
- u-e (cube) *Makes the 'you' sound rather than the 'oo' sound*
