This week's focus:

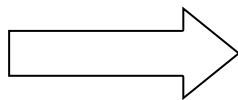
Add the prefix un to the word without changing the root word.

Activity 1

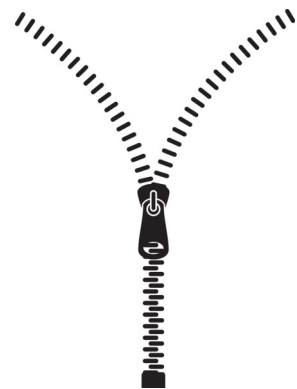
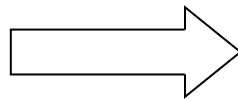
Add un at the beginning to change the meaning of the root word.



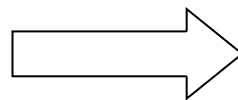
happy

Discuss how the meaning of the word changed by adding 'un' at the beginning.

Now have a go at doing these actions at home, seeing how the meaning of each word changes when you add 'un' at the beginning.

- Tie your shoes - untie your shoes.
- Wrap yourself up in a blanket - unwrap yourself from the blanket.
- Zip your jumper/coat up - unzip your jumper/coat.
- Find a place in your house that is tidy - find a place in your house which is untidy.
- Think about when you feel well - think about when you've felt unwell.
- Lock your front door - unlock your front door.
- Say something kind to someone in your family - think about when someone has said something unkind.

Once you've done that, have a go at writing the words from your spelling list.
