

Art Lesson - Tuesday 7th July

This half-term in Art we are looking at completing art relating/linked to music.

You are hopefully beginning to understand how music can affect your mood and also the way that you paint or draw.

Today we are going to start looking at how stories can affect your mood and the way you might draw or paint.

We are going to continue to focus on the local author and illustrator James Mayhew and listen to his story, Boy.

While listening to it, have a go at drawing what the story is telling you. Make sure you don't rub out your work; it's great to limit your drawing to a short time (for example the length of the story). You will notice by doing this, you draw/paint in a very different way.

You will need to listen to the story first to understand its meaning and then listen to it again to be able to draw or paint the story behind it.

I think it will be really interesting to discuss with an adult afterwards how you interpreted the story and how you've painted/drawn it.
