




# Peek at the Week

Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September



We have had a busy week in Waveney Class. Our activities have been related to the story of The Three Little Pigs. We retold the story and used a story map to help us remember the events in order. We discussed different kinds of materials and which would be best for making strong pig houses. We looked at photos of our own houses and identified the building materials.



In maths we talked about 3 in a wider context including measuring length, weight and telling time. We continued to work on addition and we introduced the concept of subtraction. We wrote some number sentences using  $+$   $-$   $=$ . We introduced cylinders and talked about their properties. We made salt dough pigs and houses for them to live in using a variety of materials. We made warning signs for the big bad wolf and snipped straws to make house pictures. We made paintbrushes using straw and had great fun painting with them.



In phonics we have been working on rhyming words, blending sounds and segmenting CVC words (e.g. c-a-t, t-a-p). Mrs Bishop's group have been writing words and sentences using single letters and digraphs).
