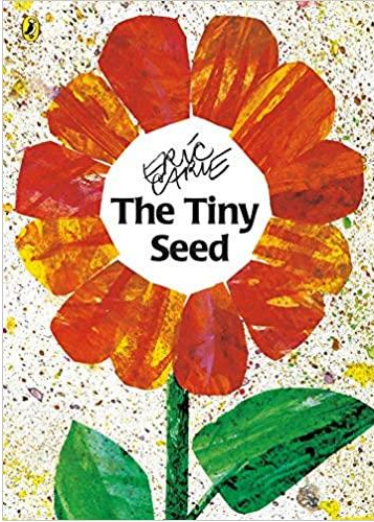


Peek at the Week

Friday 7th May



We had a really enjoyable week in Waveney class. Everyone was so busy doing lots of lovely things! We have been continuing our topic all about growing and changes. Our theme story this week was The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle. We talked about the events in the story in order and lots of us drew our own story maps, including mountains, deserts and the ocean, as well as the flower that grew from the tiny seed. We heard the story from the Bible of The Sower and the Seeds, which is a story that Jesus told. We went for a walk to look at the flowers growing around the school and wrote lists of what we saw. We drew and labelled the parts of a flowering plant and observed the plants outside carefully to draw them. We looked at pictures of flowers too, using

pastels to create our own flower pictures. Did you know that the oxlip is the county flower of Suffolk and only grows in Suffolk and the surrounding villages? Some of us decided to draw this flower. We listened to the music The Waltz of the Flowers by Tchaikovsky and made up our own dance to the music. We also sang songs related to the environments mentioned in the story.



In Maths, we did lots of flower themed counting and we used Numicon to make a flower, then calculated the total value of all our pieces and wrote the sum. Some of us completed a 1 more 1 less sheet to 20 and most could do this without using a number line.

The Nursery children became fairies this week, making fairy shoes, fairy cakes and had lots of other fairy fun.



In P.E this week, we continued with Bikeability activities, the nursery children are getting so good at balancing and Lenny shared with us the fantastic news that he has learnt to ride a bicycle independently. Well done, Lenny.

In Phonics, we revised the Phase 3 digraphs ow and oi. We practiced reading and writing words and sentences with these sounds in.

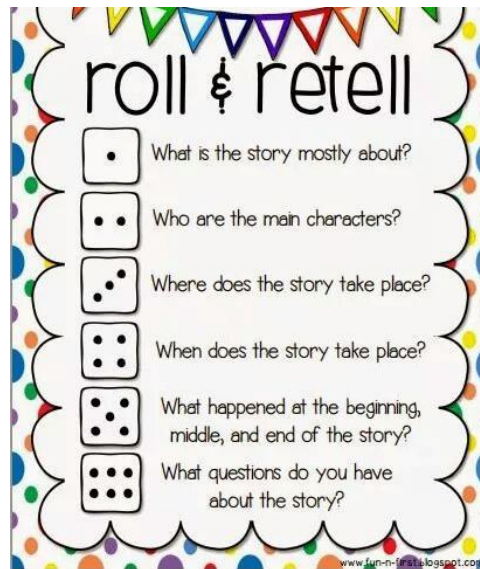
Nursery
