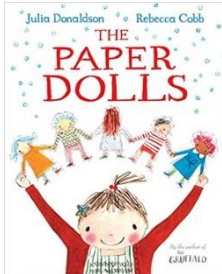




Peek at the Week

Our last story on our toys theme was *The Paper Dolls* by Julia Donaldson. We made and decorated concertina dolls and dolls with moving body parts using card and split pins. We wrote CVC words on doll chains and found all the action words in the story. Miss Hall talked to us about what it was like in Fressingfield when she was five years old and we looked at a photograph of the old school.

This week we have been joining in with lots of Christmas themed activities and have enjoyed lots of Christmas stories. We have made cards, party hats and a framed photo in our nativity costume.

In **Maths** we have been consolidating numbers to 10, working on addition and subtraction and beginning to learn number bonds. We also compared dolls by measuring how tall they are in centimetres and tried to find two that made 10cms together.

In **Phonics**, we learnt **ff ll ss** at the end of words, which completes our first look at Phase 2.

Forest Schools The children enjoyed crushing berries to make paint and used clay to make woodland animals or faces on trees.

The children were very excited to have a special visitor this morning, wearing a red suit and black boots. He even brought a sack of presents for us!
