



## Friday 24th February

Welcome back. We hope you had a good half term break. This half term our theme is giant beasts and minibeasts. We have started by focussing on dinosaurs. We collected together lots of facts and wrote a class dinosaur poem. We talked about and created different types of habitats. We used marbling to create dinosaur eggs and made them hatch a baby dinosaur. We talked about different types of dinosaurs and what they eat, using the vocabulary carnivore, herbivore, omnivore. Some children used dough to create a dinosaur skeleton (you can see Dawson's here).











As Tuesday was Shrove Tuesday we talked about what this means and how it is celebrated. Then we made and ate delicious pancakes!

On Friday we talked about how to clean our teeth and why it is important to keep our teeth clean by brushing. We watched a teeth brushing song and learnt to brush in cicles, brush your gums and tongue too. The children gave instructions to Mrs East to clean her teeth properly.

In Maths Reception have been working on 17 and made it in different ways. We revisited o'clock times on a clock face. We also talked about the sequence of events in a morning or day and drew on a timeline using first, nest, then, after that, finally.

In Phase 3 Phonics, one group has been learning the digraphs ai ee oa and the trigraph igh, reading and writing words and short phrases. The other group has been revisiting ck eu r.

The Nursery Children have been digging in sand to find dinosaur bones and printing dinosaur footprints in paint. They used white playdough to make dinosaur skeletons. They enjoyed playing a dinosaur race board game. They made handprint dinosaurs too.
