




e)(e) Peek at the Week

Friday 6th October



We have had a busy week in Waveney Class. Our activities have been related to the story of The Three Little Pigs. We made the Three Little Pig's houses out of straw, sticks and bricks and then retold the story as a class. We used a story map to help us retell the events in order and we described The Big Bad Wolf. The children came up with some really good words: "unkind" (Jude), "terrible" (Georgia, "awful" (Zanthe), "scary" (John), "nasty" (Arthur). We discussed different kinds of materials, and which would be best for making strong pig houses. We identified different building materials and types of houses.

In Maths we talked about 4 in a wider context including measuring length, weight and telling time. We continued to work on addition and we introduced the concept of subtraction. We introduced squares, rectangles and triangular-based pyramids and talked about their properties.

We made salt dough pigs and painted them. We made warning signs for the big bad wolf. We made paintbrushes using straw and had great fun painting with sticks too!











The nursery children made shape pig pictures and chose straw, sticks or printing with bricks to make houses for them. They also sang the rhyme This Little Piggy.

On Friday morning we were very excited to meet the miniature donkeys. We had a short talk in the hall, then we went outside to see them. We were able to stroke them and the Reception children took them for a walk. This was made possible for us by FOFSA, so thankyou to all the FOFSA mums who organised it.
