



Peek at the Week

Friday 19th April



We have had a very busy week this week. This term's theme is Transport. Our first focus books were Mr Gumpy's Motor Car by John Burningham and Mrs Armitage on Wheels by Quentin Blake. We brainstormed all the vehicles we could think of and labelled parts of a Car. We used vehicles in paint to make tyre



track patterns. We talked about what happened to Mrs Armitage, beginning the phrases with 'but' and 'so' and then we wrote sentences. The Reception role play area is now an emergency services call centre, and the children are enjoying pretending to be different emergency workers, such as police officers, and fire officers. We also looked at pictures of old and new cars and bicycles and compared them with modern ones.







In Maths we focussed on 21, talking about its position on a number line using the language 'before/after/between, and we found different ways of making 21. We looked at the number of wheels on 1 Car, 2 Cars, 3 Cars and so on. Then we drew a picture and wrote the numbers to show how many wheels on different amounts of bicycles.

In Phonics, we have learnt the digraphs ar or and ur. We also read and wrote sentences containing the tricky word be, or Be if it was at the beginning of a sentence.

We had a wonderful time at Forest School despite the weather. We spent time identifying trees, digging in our digging area, playing in the mud kitchen, swinging in the hammock, building dens, climbing trees and playing hide-and-seek. At the end of the day, we enjoyed biscuits and a delicious hot chocolate!







The Nursery children have also been making junk model vehicles and are very proud of them.
